Features

13,000ft² expansion to
bring people together to
broaden our sense of
family and community.

- 3,451 sq ft community room, able to be divided
- 3,900 sq ft outdoor covered pavilion
- Remodel of numerous areas in the main library
 - ◊ Larger teen room with better layout
 - ◊ Larger local history/genealogy room
 - ◊ Better public services desk to meet the evolving needs of library users
- Outdoor reading area
- ADA-accessible walking trail around property

Project Timeline

August 2024 | Architect hired to conduct a building feasibility study

August 2025 | Building and Financial feasibility studies complete

October 2025 | Approval by LCPL board and Logan County Fiscal Court

November 2025 | Architect begins working with library on design phase

Future actions, such as bidding, bonding, and construction, will be updated as estimated dates are finalized. Currently, construction is anticipated to last 12 months.

Funding

- Cash input from library's existing capital reserves
- Municipal bond issue
- Grant opportunities are a primary focus before bidding
