




































# Logan County Public Library

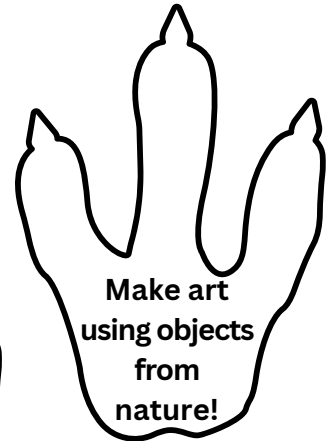
